

## UCAMA Construction Report #8

Because of the number of inquiries we have received regarding the progress of our new museum facility on Jasper Avenue, UCAMA has decided to prepare month end construction reports. These reports will be sent out to our friends and supporters until Phase 1 is complete.

Although construction is expected to slow down until March, work is still progressing. The site will be shut down at  $-30^{\circ}$ . The basement supports for the first floor, which was poured last month, can be removed after the floor has cured for 28 days. (Please see the photo of the basement supports in Construction Report #7.)



The columns on the west wall of the Lodge have been framed in and the concrete poured. They are covered with tarps to allow enough heat to build up to properly cure the columns. Interestingly the rebar in the columns retains heat from the poured concrete assisting in the curing process. The columns in the middle of the building have also been poured and covered with tarps.
