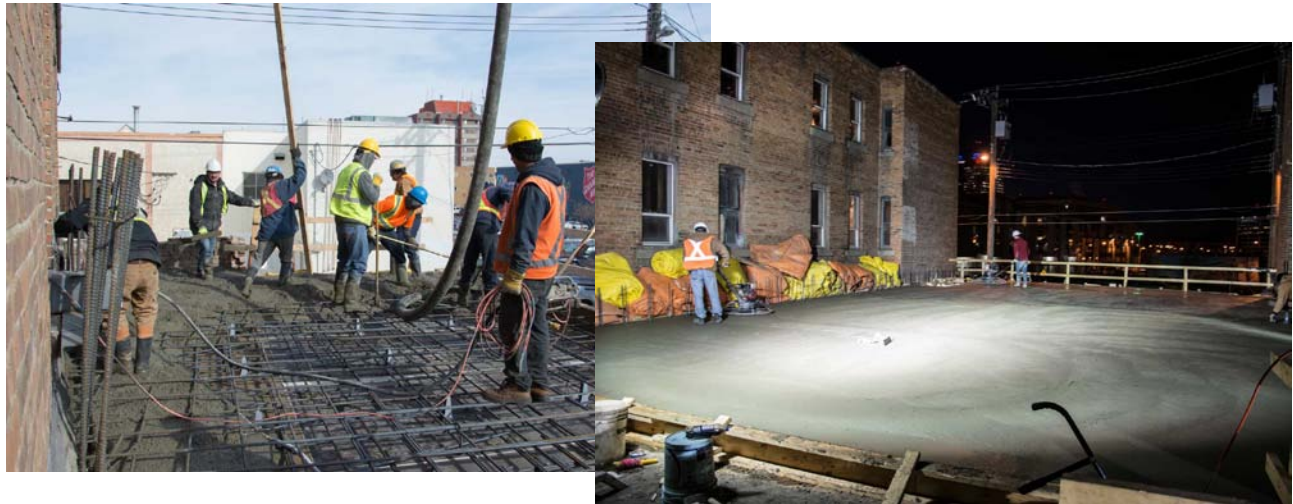


UCAMA Construction Report #9

Because of the number of inquiries we have received regarding the progress of our new museum facility on Jasper Avenue, UCAMA has decided to prepare month end construction reports. These reports will be sent out to our friends and supporters until Phase 1 is complete.

Although the winter may have slowed construction, the contractors have nonetheless made considerable progress, the most notable of which is the pouring of the second floor on April 2. The floor will be cured by the end of the month.



The west wall of the museum which abuts the Brighton Block has been extended upward to a height equal to the bottom of the third floor. The space between this concrete block wall and the Brighton block clearly seen in the photograph is the result of the building code to retard the possible spread of fire between the two buildings. It will not be visible when the building is completed.



The extension on the east side of the museum is also moving upward. The rebar for the columns is already in place.
